Vinateria Idilico is Pomum Cellars' sister brand focusing exclusively on Spanish variety wines grown in Washington State. Idilico is the name of a famous Bull that performed in the Barcelona Bullfight Ring in 2008. He was so "brave" that he earned a pardon and was spared from the Matador's sword. Needless to say this is a very rare occurrence and a great victory for this magnificent creature. The goal for Idilico wines, is to bring to the consumer's attention the potential of Spanish grape varieties in the great Washington State vineyards. Our first white is a beautiful Albariño to which we will follow with a Rosado, Garnacha, Tempranillo, Monastrell and Graciano. Down the road we hope to showcase Verdejo, Viura, Mencia and others.

2019 Idilico Rosado

The first Rose of the winery and a favorite for spring and summer outdoor gatherings. The wine was farmed specifically for Rose and is a blend of 63% Graciano, 23% Garnacha and 14% Monastrell from the Yakima Valley AVA. It was fermented in stainless steel tank and aged on the skins for 4 months before bottling. No malolactic fermentation was allowed. The wine was lightly cold stabilized, fined and filtered before being bottled in April 2020. Alcohol is 12.5%, TA 6.0 g/l, PH 3.36. Only 170 cases produced.

The wine shows notes of fresh picked strawberry and raspberry with a backdrop of tropical fruit. On the palate there is plenty of nerve and crisp, refreshing flavors. Drink anytime the sun shines.
